- Trail brushing/renting of bobcat with brusher will be done over Thanksgiving weekend timeframe. Friday, November 28th has been scheduled. Contact Steve Hohag.
- Grant still not back from the DNR. Expect it soon, will be the same as previous years.
- Hassan: Conditional Use Permit has been filed and \$200.00 for this fee and escrow of \$1000.00. Landowners within 500' get notified, Nov 20 planning meeting, if accepted it gets to town board which is Dec 1 for approval. We can get by if need be but trying to keep it where it's been for years.
- Hwy 55: Loretto to Rockford is a go and will be marked to the Crow River. Wright County is excited about this and found out they groom the Lake Sarah area which is a help. Randy will mark this section, Bob will mark hazards!
- Cty Rd 30: 116 to Hwy 19 then down to Stormans station. These two sections will add approx 20-25 miles to our system. Will be marked November 15th or 16th.
- Baker Park is NOT closed. Park policy is if no GIA trail comes into the park it's closed. This is temporary in nature at this point. We need to make a connection on the north or the south side to keep this open. It will be a sticky situation as to what designates a GIA trail and what doesn't.
- Larkin Road down to Polairs is out right now. Butch and Wally are working on it, also Mark knows connections to allow a possibility further west around that bad section. Appears to not be a major issue.
- Maple Grove: Winter wheat field will allow us through so were good through there with a bit of a re-route.
